

GRADUATION ASSESSMENTS

Graduation assessments are changing to align with the new curriculum. As part of the updated graduation requirements, students in the 2018 Graduation Program will have to complete two* provincial assessments. They will focus on the demonstration and application of numeracy and literacy.

NUMERACY

The numeracy assessment will be introduced in June of the 2017/18 school year.

LITERACY

The literacy assessment will be introduced in the 2018/19 school year (all Language Arts 12 examinations will continue until that time, and then be phased out in the process).

English 12 & Communications 12

Students taking English 12 or Communications 12 this year, will still need to write the provincial exam for these courses. To start the registration process, please contact your course teacher.

NEW STUDENT TRANSCRIPT SERVICE

The Ministry of Education has just launched the StudentTranscripts Service (STS), a new online application for students to view their marks, scholarships and transcripts, and send transcripts to post-secondary institutions and third parties.

To access the service, students will go to the Ministry of Education's transcripts and certificates website at www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca. Please note that all students must register for a BC Government account (a BCeID). After registering for a BCeID, students follow the system prompts and register for STS. Finally, they log in to the StudentTranscripts Service using the BCeID.

GRADUATING STUDENTS

Now is a great time to start applying for Post Secondary Institutions and Scholarships.

Schulich Leader Scholarship - \$80,000 - \$100,000 for students intending to pursue a career in STEM - school must nominate a representative by Feb 1.

BC Excellence Scholarship - \$5000 - school nominee must apply by early Feb

Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship - \$5000 - deadline to apply is Feb 15

District/Authority Scholarship - \$1250 - deadline to apply is early March

Anchor Academy Christian Post Secondary Bursary - approx \$2500 - deadline to apply is April 30

Check entrance scholarships for the Post Secondary Institution to which you are applying




