British Columbia's New Curriculum

The redesigned Grade 10 curriculum will be implemented at the beginning of the 2018/2019 school year. Grade 11 and 12 will be implemented the following school year. For more information see: https://curriculum.gov.bc.ca/

Provincial Exams and Graduation Assessments

Graduation assessments are changing to align with the new curriculum. As part of the updated graduation requirements, students in the 2018 Graduation Program will need to complete two provincial assessments. The provincial assessments will focus on the demonstration and application of numeracy and literacy. Students will have two opportunities to re-write these assessments during their graduation years should they wish to increase their proficiency. Their best outcome will be recorded on their final transcript. More information can be found at: https://curriculum.gov.bc.ca/provincial-assessment/graduation

Numeracy Assessment
Students who will be meeting graduation requirements after June 30, 2018 who have not written a Math 10 provincial exam will be required to write this assessment in order to graduate.

Literacy Assessment

This assessment is still under development and will be introduced in the 2019/2020 school year. The English 12 and Communications 12 provincial exams will remain in place until then.

Please <u>note:</u>

- Exams must be written at educational institutions and supervised by certified teachers or school administrators.
- Students residing in the Shuswap/North Okanagan Region will write their exams/assessments at the Anchor Academy office in Salmon Arm.
- Students residing outside the Shuswap/North Okanagan Region will receive the help of Anchor Academy's exam coordinator to establish exam locations in their regions during the January and June sessions only.
- Students wishing to write in November, April or August must either write the exam at Anchor Academy or make their own arrangements at an approved educational institution.

Registering for Exams/Assessments

To register for the English 12 or Communications provincial exam, contact your *course teacher*. To register for the Numeracy Assessment, contact our exam coordinator at exams@ark.net.

Deadlines to register with Anchor Academy are:

- Last Friday in November for the January session
- Last Friday in April for the June session
- Any students requiring Special Format Assessments must notify the High School Vice Principal at least four months prior to the exam day

Scholarships and Bursaries

Schulich Leader Scholarship: \$80,000 - \$100,000 for students intending to pursue a career in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics). The school must nominate a representative by February 1.

BC Excellence Scholarship: \$5,000. The school nominee must apply by early February.

Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship: \$5,000. The deadline to apply is February 15.

District/Authority Scholarship: \$1,250. The deadline to apply is early March.

Anchor Academy Christian Post Secondary Bursary: Up to \$2,500. The deadline to apply is April 30. Every year, Anchor Academy offers generous bursaries to students entering Christian Post-Secondary Institutions. Applicants must be taking at least 5 courses from Anchor Academy in their graduating year.
