

Graduating Students

For those students graduating this year, please review the following information:

Applying to Post Secondary Institutions (PSI's) – Students need to apply to each PSI separately. This can now be done through https://www.educationplannerbc.ca/.

Ordering Transcripts – Students can have transcripts sent directly to their PSI's of choice through the Student Transcripts Service http://www.studenttranscripts.gov.bc.ca/.

Scholarships and Bursaries

- <u>Schulich Leader Scholarship</u> \$80,000 \$100,000 for students intending to pursue a career in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics) school must nominate a representative by February 1.
- BC Excellence Scholarship \$5000 school nominee must apply by early February
- Pathway to Teacher Education Scholarship \$5000 deadline to apply is February 15
- <u>District/Authority Scholarship</u> \$1250 deadline to apply is early March
- Anchor Academy Christian Post-Secondary Bursary up to \$2500 deadline to apply is April 30. Every year, Anchor Academy offers generous bursaries to students entering Christian Post-Secondary Institutions. Applicants must be taking at least 5 courses from Anchor Academy in their graduating year.
- <u>Entrance Scholarships</u> most Post-Secondary Institutions offer their own entrance scholarships
- Community Scholarships Several community groups offer scholarships as well.


